High-performance film which is composed of a $100-\mu m$, photoluminescent, white-light green, cast PVC and coated with a pressure-sensitive, solvent-based, acrylic adhesive. Product intended for decorative or artistic application in accordance with the classification A of the DIN67510-1: 2020 standard. For indoor application. Glossy surface finish.

• Resistance to solvents: the adhesive is resistant to most chemicals (alcohol, petrol, diluted acids, oils, fuels).

ADHESIVE:

- Solvent-based, acrylic adhesive.
- Immediate and permanent adhesion, suitable for wet application to flat surfaces only.

USER'S INSTRUCTIONS:

- The film is intended for indoor application.
- The film can be cut into simple shapes using a plotter.
- It is possible to transfer the film with the HEX904, HEX909 or HEX860 tapes.
- Recommended minimum application temperature: +7 °C (+45 °F).
- Operating temperature range: between -40 °C and +90 °C (-40 °F and +194 °F).
- Recharge the photoluminescent properties of the film under natural or artificial lighting.
- In the case of an already painted substrate, self-adhesive media must only be applied to undamaged original paintwork. If the paintwork is not original and/or damaged, the application and the removal are at the judgement and risk of the installer.

OPERATING RECOMMENDATIONS:

 The colour of the films is controlled by HEXIS in order to ensure faithful reproduction of their colour tints. Nevertheless, in the case that your project requires the use of several rolls of the same colour reference, HEXIS recommend using only a single batch number of each reference.

STORAGE:

• Shelf life (before application):

The shelf life of this film is 2 years when stored in its unopened original packaging at a temperature ranging from 15 $^{\circ}$ C to 25 $^{\circ}$ C (+59 $^{\circ}$ F to +77 $^{\circ}$ F) with relative humidity between 30 $^{\circ}$ 8 and 70 $^{\circ}$ 8.

DURABILITY:

• Vertical indoor exposure: up to 3 years.
